Requirements for registration:

All new students are expected to know the basic rules and moves *before attending class*. This basic knowledge is available at no charge on our website and our 'practice site' (Chess.com). **Students who have not yet learned these basics should not be registered until they have done so.**

C&O Family Chess Center offers unique programs aimed at nurturing a love of the game of chess, and offering students and families the means to develop their skills to the highest levels. **Parents are as essential as coaches in encouraging students to practice regularly and come to class on time and prepared.** Registration on Chess.com (our online practice site) is the responsibility of parents. This 'between classes' portion of the club is essential for the full benefit of our program.
